A Kids Fun Run inside Dietz Stadium will offer supervised children's activities to parents in the 5K.

Funds raised through the event will benefit the Foundation's Rosemary D. Gruner Memorial Cancer Fund which provides financial assistance to local cancer patients while they receive treatment; over 1600 patients have been served.
